NEAMA SCHOLARSHIP FUND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

THE PROGRAM

The program will be called the NEAMA Scholarship Fund.

The sponsor will be New England Adjustment Managers Association (NEAMA).

ELIGIBILITIES

Applicants must –

- be college undergraduate or graduate students with projected graduation more than one year from application date. First preference will be given to students who are pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in business or related liberal arts degree program (accounting, banking, economics, industrial relations, marketing, professional studies, statistics, computer sciences) at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university.
- be a citizen of the United States of America.
- be sponsored by an active NEAMA Member or Associate Member whose dues have been paid on or before October 31st 2016.

Members and children of members are eligible to apply.

AWARDS

The program will utilize standard Scholarship Management Services recipient selection procedures including the consideration of past academic performance and future potential, leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, statement of career and educational aspirations and goals, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal.

Financial need will be considered in determining the amount of each award. Potential recipients who demonstrate no need will be eligible to receive an honorarium at the minimum amount.

Annual awards will be determined by the annual fundraising totals and Executive Committee determination with award sizes varying in amount. Scholarship recipients will not be eligible to receive the top award amount in consecutive program years.

Awards are not renewable; however, students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements. Awards are for undergraduate or graduate study.
